Or that people from as far way as the Florida Keys, Texas, Alabama and Massachusetts would contact her asking how they could get her the pull tabs they had collected. Universities in New York, New Jersey and Virginia, elementary schools in Maryland and Maine and local charitable organizations all over Virginia, Maryland and Washington DC have also contacted the staff at PTFC to see how they can collect tabs and get them to the Bethesda, Maryland based charity.

PTFC honors the efforts and spirit of a courageous breast cancer patient, Jodyann Faber, who was committed to helping others before and throughout her extended illness. Says Faber, "Jody would be thrilled to tears that organizations and individuals from far and wide are still collecting and recycling tabs." Pull Tabs for Charity primarily raises funds by sponsoring semi-annual fund raising events in the Washington DC Metropolitan area. PTFC also raises funds by sponsoring an ongoing aluminum pull tab recycling program with the assistance of a generous local scrap metal recycling company, Montgomery Scrap Corporation.
