For those who may not already know, the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries, Inc. (ISRI) is a Washington, DC based, non-profit trade association that represent the interests of its approximately 1600 member-companies, which operate over 3,000 facilities world-wide. As their website indicates, the ISRI continues to be the “**Voice of the Recycling Scrap Industry**” and represent the interests of companies that process, broker, and industrially consume scrap commodities. PTFC and the ISRI began discussing the creation of a formal alliance on August 4, 2008 and the alliance was tentatively approved by the ISRI Board of Directors & Governors during their October 2008 National Convention & Exhibition, which this year took place in San Francisco, California.

The planned alliance will permit PTFC supporters throughout the country to drop off collected pull tabs at ISRI member-companies located in all 50 states.
